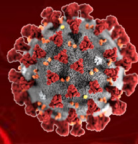

Uses:

- Operating Capital to pay bills

(Construction or machinery and equipment purchases, etc. are ineligible costs.)

Eligible Businesses:

- All non-franchise, For-Profit businesses meeting the following criteria:
 - Located in Fayette County, PA
 - Maximum of 100 Full-Time Equivalent (FTE) Employees
 - Three (3) years in operation
 - Listed as a “Non-Essential Business” by Governor Tom Wolf

Loan applications will be accepted until the Fund is depleted.

Fay-Penn Small Business Emergency Loan Fund

In response to the COVID-19 situation, Fay-Penn Economic Development Council has launched an Small Business Emergency Loan Fund (SBELF) for Fayette County small businesses. The SBELF can be used by eligible small businesses to pay their bills, and is intended to supplement other programs offered by the United States and Pennsylvania governments, and other public and private organizations.

- ***Loans up to \$20,000***
- ***Interest Rate at 2.99% fixed***
- ***Terms of up to 60 months***
 - ***No payments for 60 days (no interest accrued)***
 - ***Interest only for next 90 days***
- ***No Prepayment Penalty***
